

## **SCHOOL CHOICE PROCEDURE**

Revised: October 2008

The following procedure shall be adhered to and is necessary to control the growth in all schools within the Appoquinimink School District for choice applicants outside of the district and those requesting choice within district.

### **A. School Choice Application Within District and Selection Criteria**

- 1) Choice Applications will be accepted from October to the deadline, the second Wednesday of each January, as indicated by the Department of Education, for the next school year.
- 2) Applications are to be submitted or sent to the following address, not submitted to the individual school:  
**Appoquinimink District Office, C/O School Choice, 118 S. Sixth Street, PO 4010, Odessa, DE 19730-4010**
- 3) All applications must be postmarked or received in person by 4:00 p.m. on the identified closing date, the second Wednesday of January. Applications must be complete with appropriate attachments, if necessary.
- 4) Applications received after the January deadline will be placed on a wait list and held for processing until July 15. At that time, a determination will be made if enough capacity exists at the desired school to grant the choice request.
- 5) Capacity will be the key factor when considering applications for choice approval. If a school is at 80% capacity, it will be closed to choice students. In addition, choice students will not be permitted to exceed 5% of the school's population.
- 6) The reason for requesting choice must be clearly indicated on the choice application. Requests based on daycare provisions will be considered.
- 7) Choice applications are reviewed and approved ANNUALLY. Anyone wanting to remain in their school of choice for the subsequent school year must submit another application by the deadline date for the following school year.
- 8) Consideration will be given for Good Cause late applications (within district only).  
**Good Cause for late applications may be considered for one of the following reasons:**
  - Change in child's residence due to a change in family residence;
  - Change in the state in which the family residence is located;
  - Change in a child's parent marital status;
  - Change caused by a guardianship proceeding;
  - Placement of a child in foster care/adoption;
  - Participation by a child in a substance abuse or mental health treatment program;
  - Or a similar set of circumstances consistent with the definition of "Good Cause" as determined by the district.
- 9) Students and parents will be notified of the school choice decision by the end of February and the applications are processed in the order in which they are received.
- 10) Approved applicants are given 10 days to sign and return the "Invitation to Attend" form. Otherwise, the application will be revoked.

### **B. School Choice for high school students**

The Appoquinimink School District can only permit school choice at the high school level for students if there is an older sibling who currently attends Middletown High School. Other than the above-mentioned, there is to be no school choice between Appoquinimink and Middletown High Schools. This option will not be available after the 2010/2011 school year.

### **C. School Choice from outside the district**

- The application process is the same as above; however, the rapid and constant growth of the district continues to deter approval of applicants with residence outside of this living district.
- Consideration is extended to families who can prove imminent residency to the district (i.e., signed builder's contract, lease agreement, etc.) with permanent residency prior to the end of the calendar year of said school year. Delaware residency needs to be established before the application can be adequately processed.

### **D. School Choice for Title I Schools Under Improvement**

Based on Delaware State Testing Program (DSTP) results, a Title I school could be placed Under Improvement until they have met Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for two consecutive years. This identification means several things for the schools. If a school has been identified as under improvement, parents/guardians with children enrolled in that school may elect to send their child(ren) to another school in the district that has not been identified as under improvement for said school year.

**E. Charter Schools** All requests for admission into Charter Schools must be made directly to the Charter. It is not a school choice process.

**F. Application Withdrawal** A choice application may be withdrawn by written notification to the receiving district.

### **G. School Choice Revoked/Denied**

- Should a choice student have difficulty with tardiness, absences, or any unacceptable behavior as indicated in the Student Code of Conduct his/her school choice may be revoked.
- Applications will be denied for students who have been expelled from another school or school district until the student is eligible for readmission.
- Once a parent chooses their child out of our district, the child cannot return for a period of one school year unless it meets one of the "Good Cause" provisions as defined by the district.

### **H. Transportation**

Unless other arrangements are made with daycare facilities, for all approved choice requests, the parents/guardians are to provide transportation to and from the choice school without infringing on the student's regular school day with frequent tardiness and/or early pickups.

### **I. Participation in Interscholastic Sports**

Students will be governed by the rules of the DIAA with regard to athletic eligibility of transferring students. Students for whom this is a concern should check with the principal of the school(s) being considered for choice.

# Delaware Department of Education

## School Choice Application for 2009—10

### General Information

- Deadlines for applying without meeting good cause: (applications are to be received by the desired choice district office)  
Students applying for grades 1-12: **Wednesday, January 14, 2009**  
Students applying for kindergarten have until the first day of the school year. Check with the school district(s) to which you are applying to determine other kindergarten information.
- Delaware students may apply to one or more districts. Local school districts establish the number of choices within their districts.
- Separate applications are required for each student; one application for each student and for each district.
- Some school districts require more information than is on the state application form. Please check with the district(s) to which you are applying to determine what additional information is required.
- Parent, guardian or Relative Caregiver acceptance of an invitation to enroll in a school of your choice commits the student to remain in that school for two years, or until the program or grade level configuration is completed, unless released by the district.
- Late applications may be accepted by the choice district office for “good cause”. Call the appropriate district office for their policy on “Good Cause”.

### Grade 1-12 Applications:

1. School boards must consider the application before the end of February 2009. Applicants will be notified about the school district’s action within a few days of the board meeting. The response will include one of three answers: (1) invited to enroll, (2) placed on a waiting list, or (3) not accepted.
2. Applicants who are special education students must have a current copy of their Individualized Education Program (IEP) attached to the application. It is the responsibility of the applicant to get the copy from the present school and attach it to the application. The application will not be considered without this information.
3. Initial invitations must be accepted or rejected by the applicant in writing. Responses must be received by the choice district office on or before March 16, 2009. If no response is received from the applicant, the invitation will be considered to have been rejected.
4. If more than one school district extends an invitation, please make your selection as soon as possible so the rejected position for next year can be offered to another student.
5. As openings in a school and grade become available, the school district may invite applicants who are on the waiting list. Please respond to these invitations as soon as possible.
6. Invitations to waiting list applicants who live in another school district must be accepted by a written confirmation and be received by the choice district office at a time established by the district, but no later than April 20, 2009. After this date, the invitation will no longer be valid.
7. Invitations are for specific schools and specific grades — if a student is not promoted this year he/she may not be eligible to enroll in the choice school because of space limitations. If this happens, immediately contact the accepting school district.

### Kindergarten Applications

School boards must consider the application before June 15, 2009, or within 45 days of receipt. Applicants will be notified about the school district’s action within five (5) days of the board meeting. The response will include one of three answers: (1) invited to enroll, (2) placed on a waiting list, or (3) not accepted. The student must have had his/her fifth (5th) birthday on or before August 31, 2009. Check with the school district(s) to which you are applying to determine other kindergarten information.

### Transportation

If parents choose to send their children to a public school outside of the district where they live, they are responsible for getting their children to the school or to a bus stop on that school’s route. The Transportation stipends were discontinued by legislative action in FY09 (2008-09 School Year).

### Solicitudes para 1° a 12° Grado

- 1) Los consejos escolares deben analizar la solicitud antes de **fin de febrero de 2005**. Los solicitantes serán notificados de la determinación del distrito escolar unos pocos días después de la reunión del consejo. La notificación incluirá una de tres respuestas: (1) invitado a matricularse, (2) colocado en lista de espera, o (3) no aceptado.
- 2) Los estudiantes que reciben educación especial deben adjuntar a su solicitud una copia actual de su Programa Individualizado de Educación (“IEP”). El solicitante es responsable por obtener la copia de su escuela actual y adjuntarla a la solicitud. La solicitud **no** será analizada sin esta información.
- 3) El solicitante debe aceptar o rechazar por escrito las invitaciones iniciales. Las respuestas deben ser recibidas en la oficina del distrito encargada del proceso de elección **a más tardar el 15 de marzo de 2005**. Si no se recibe una respuesta del solicitante, se considerará que la invitación ha sido rechazada.
- 4) Si más de un distrito escolar lo invita a matricularse, por favor realice su elección lo antes posible de modo tal que la vacante rechazada para el año próximo pueda ser ofrecida a otro estudiante.
- 5) A medida que se produzcan vacantes en una escuela y grado, el distrito escolar podrá invitar a solicitantes que estén en la lista de espera. Por favor responda a estas invitaciones lo antes posible.
- 6) Las invitaciones hechas a solicitantes en lista de espera que viven en otro distrito escolar deben ser aceptadas a través de una confirmación por escrito que debe ser recibida en la oficina del distrito encargada del proceso de elección cuando el distrito lo establezca, pero nunca después del **19 de abril de 2005**. Después de dicha fecha la invitación perderá validez.
- 7) Las invitaciones se realizan para escuelas específicas y grados específicos - si un estudiante no pasa de grado este año, puede ser que él/ella no pueda matricularse en su escuela de elección debido a limitaciones de espacio. Si esto sucede, póngase en contacto de inmediato con el distrito escolar que lo aceptó.

### Solicitudes para Kindergarten

Los consejos escolares deben analizar la solicitud antes del **15 de junio de 2005 o dentro de los 45 días de haberla recibido**. Los solicitantes serán notificados de la determinación del distrito escolar dentro de los cinco (5) días siguientes a la reunión del consejo. La notificación incluirá una de tres respuestas: (1) invitado a matricularse, (2) colocado en lista de espera, o (3) no aceptado. **El estudiante debe haber cumplido los cinco (5) años de edad antes del 31 de agosto de 2005 o ese mismo día.**

### Transporte

Si los padres deciden enviar a sus hijos a una escuela pública ubicada fuera del distrito donde viven, los padres tendrán la responsabilidad de llevar a sus hijos a la escuela o a una parada de la ruta del autobús correspondiente a la escuela. Es posible obtener asistencia financiera para los gastos familiares de transporte si se cumplen **TODOS** los siguientes cuatro requisitos:

1. El niño asiste a una escuela pública en un distrito distinto al distrito donde vive;
2. El niño está anotado en el Programa Nacional de Almuerzo Escolar a fin de recibir almuerzos gratis o a precio reducido.
3. El niño reúne los requisitos para recibir servicio de transporte porque está en **escuela primaria (K a 6° grado)** y vive a más de **una milla** de la escuela a la que asiste o está en **escuela secundaria (7° a 12° grado)** y vive a más de **dos millas** de la escuela a la que asiste.
4. Su hijo **no** está recibiendo servicio de transporte o debe recorrer más de media milla para llegar a la parada del autobús.
